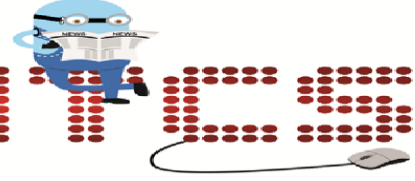

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

STUDENT TEAM WINS MIT COVID-19 CHALLENGE

A crew of three students - Akshatha Kamath (CSE), Shubham Rateria (CCE 2019 Batch) and Adri Rajaraman (ECE 2019 Batch) has emerged victorious in the Massachusetts Institute of Technology COVID-19 challenge - 'Beat the Pandemic'. They narrowed down to the problem of overcrowded hospitals with inappropriate admissions, whereas less than 5% of the average population under 50 years of age requires hospitalisation. Their solution was to build a Tele Health platform for non-contact monitoring of vital signs, such as heart rate, respiratory rate and blood oxygen concentration using just a phone camera, or webcam at home.

ARYAMAN WINS 4TH BEST ADJUDICATOR AT NUALS PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE COMPETITION STUDENT RESEARCH RECOGNITION

Aryaman Kohli, a second year student, has been awarded as the 4th best adjudicator in the NUALS Parliamentary Debate competition held at Kochi, Kerala from 28th February to 1st March 2020. He has also got qualified as a finalist in the debate tournament.

MIT STUDENTS BAG SECOND PRIZE AT CODE19 ONLINE HACKATHON AGAINST COVID-19

A student team comprising of Megha Baid (CSE), Shivangi Shukla (CSE), Rakshit Naidu (CSE), Jithin Sunny (EEE), Joel Jogy George (E&C) and Rohan Rout (EEE) secured the second prize of \$5000 in the Code19 Hackathon conducted by Silicon-Valley based Motwani Jadeja Foundation and HackerEarth. The team's solution, 'Televital', enables remote monitoring of vitals and will make hospital admissions more efficient, reducing the burden on medical staff and equipment.

◆ The faculty members have published ten research papers in Scopus and Web of Science indexed journals during January to May 2020.

◆ Dr. Manjunath K N has published his Ph.D abstract in the Medical Physics journal published online by American Association of Physicists in Medicine (AAPM) on 30th April 2020. The journal publishes research works on ensuring accuracy, safety, and quality in the use of radiation in medical imaging and radiation therapy.

This award represents the highest level of educational achievement in Toastmasters and recognizes the public speaking and leadership achievements of a member.
